



Dear Parents:

Did you know that your student may be able to earn college credit in their high school class(es)? If your child is *currently enrolled* in a **Tech Prep** class, they may be eligible to earn **tuition free** college credit *right now* in addition to their high school credit (this is called “Dual Credit”). Tech Prep is a nationwide education program that operates throughout the nation and is *endorsed* and *supported* by this school district! To earn college credit your student must:

1. Register for dual credit while they are enrolled in the high school class! (www.techprepcc.org)
2. Pay the non-refundable \$46 annual consortium fee (<http://pay.techprepcc.org>)
3. Receive a grade of “B” or higher in the class.

What is Tech Prep?

Tech Prep is a program that enables students to earn college credit in high school courses that are formally aligned – articulated – with college courses. Teachers from high schools and colleges work together to ensure the high school classes match the course competencies of the college-level course. Most of the ‘Tech Prep’ high school classes articulated are part of a Career and Technical Education (CTE) program and they connect with a professional/technical certificate or degree. By participating in the program, students can begin to focus on building real-world skills and career knowledge that connects to high-demand, high-level professions, from marketing to health care to information technology.

- Explore a career and earn college credits while still in high school
- Save hundreds (or thousands) of dollars on tuition, fees, books & transportation!
- Explore careers requiring the development of related academic skills in mathematics, communication, science and technology!

- Begin training for high paying, in-demand careers and employment opportunities
